Swim Float Project:

We collected \$9,730. Rotem got us a discount and our cost for materials was \$8,300. That leaves us with a \$1,450 balance. However, we have not removed the old dock yet, or disposed of any of the Styrofoam or old materials.

We will need another work party to accomplish that. Rotem is tasked with gathering divers to unhook the old dock and see what's going on under there.

We have had no extraordinary expenses lately. We will have expenses for the 4th of July parade, but we are currently in a solid financial position.

Lake Monitor Report: Alden Chace

Currently the lake temperature is 12 degrees C, 68 degrees F.

Alden is now retiring, he has been monitoring the lake for us and for King County since 1998. He attended our meeting to find a replacement and to explain to us what he does once a week to keep information current on our beloved lake.

- He has a water temperature and depth recorder from King County that sits on his dock, he says it can stay there if someone wants to come and take the readings.
- Once a week he takes his boat out to take water clarity readings.
- He also reports on cloud cover and wind conditions that day.
- He keeps track of algae blooms and particle counts and how many people are using the lake at that time.
