Beach Lot News:

We had an agenda item concerning our dock at our shared beach lot.

Queen Tani Rae has an estimate from a local contractor to replace the rotting log floats and styrofoam.

\$4000 in materials and \$3500 in labor costs. This includes removal of any Styrofoam and dump fees.

A suggestion was made to hold a fundraiser to repair the beach lot dock.

A suggestion was made to open a separate account for the dock repair.

A suggestion was made to ask for volunteers to save on labor costs. A suggestion was made to get another estimate for comparison. Queen Tani Rae will get another estimate and we will discuss further.

Illegal Fireworks Discussion:

Angle Lake Neighbors suffered repeated percussive firework explosions on the 4th of July. Our local Resource Officer told us at our Block Watch meeting that because of the way laws were written in SeaTac they were impossible to enforce. First the last minute change to allow *certain* fireworks, was not introduced in time nor were the officers educated on what is illegal and legal. Second the law as written does not allow a citation and fine unless the office witnesses the offending illegal firework being deployed. He encouraged us to write to our local council members to address this issue and avoid confusion next year.

We were told that the city of Sammamish managed to change the law so that an officer could fine the household that set off illegal fireworks by just observing them go off above the house, witnessing the person setting them off wasn't necessary.

Signatures were collected to send a petition to the offending household to let them know that we as a community wish them to cease and desist.

You can help by writing to council members and asking them to re-write the law regarding legal fireworks in SeaTac so our police officers have an actionable response to illegal fireworks in the city.

We believe that Deputy Mayor Negusse and Peter Kwon are the most familiar with our neighborhood. The more of you who write, the more seriously they will take this issue. Simply state your name and address and request they rewrite the laws so that homeowners can be cited and fined for illegal fireworks being deployed from their property without the officer having to witness the actual lighting.
