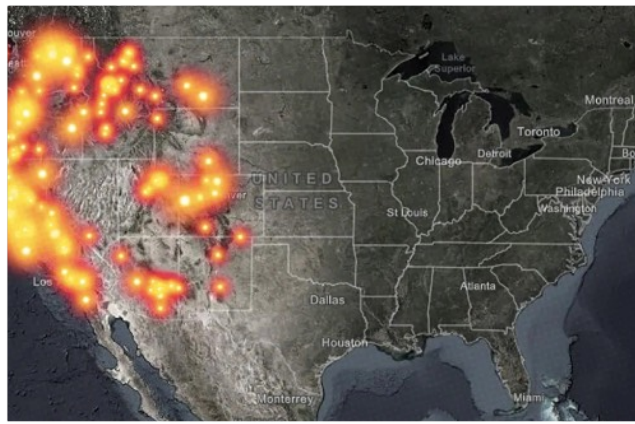
The city did test the water before and after the races to see if water pollution might be a factor in the decision to continue racing. The result actually showed less gas, diesel, fuel in the water the Monday after the races than there was the Friday before the races. Perhaps the stirring of the waters impacted this. They were not sure the reason but those were the results. Therefore, the determining factor, if races continue will probably be the results of the survey.
